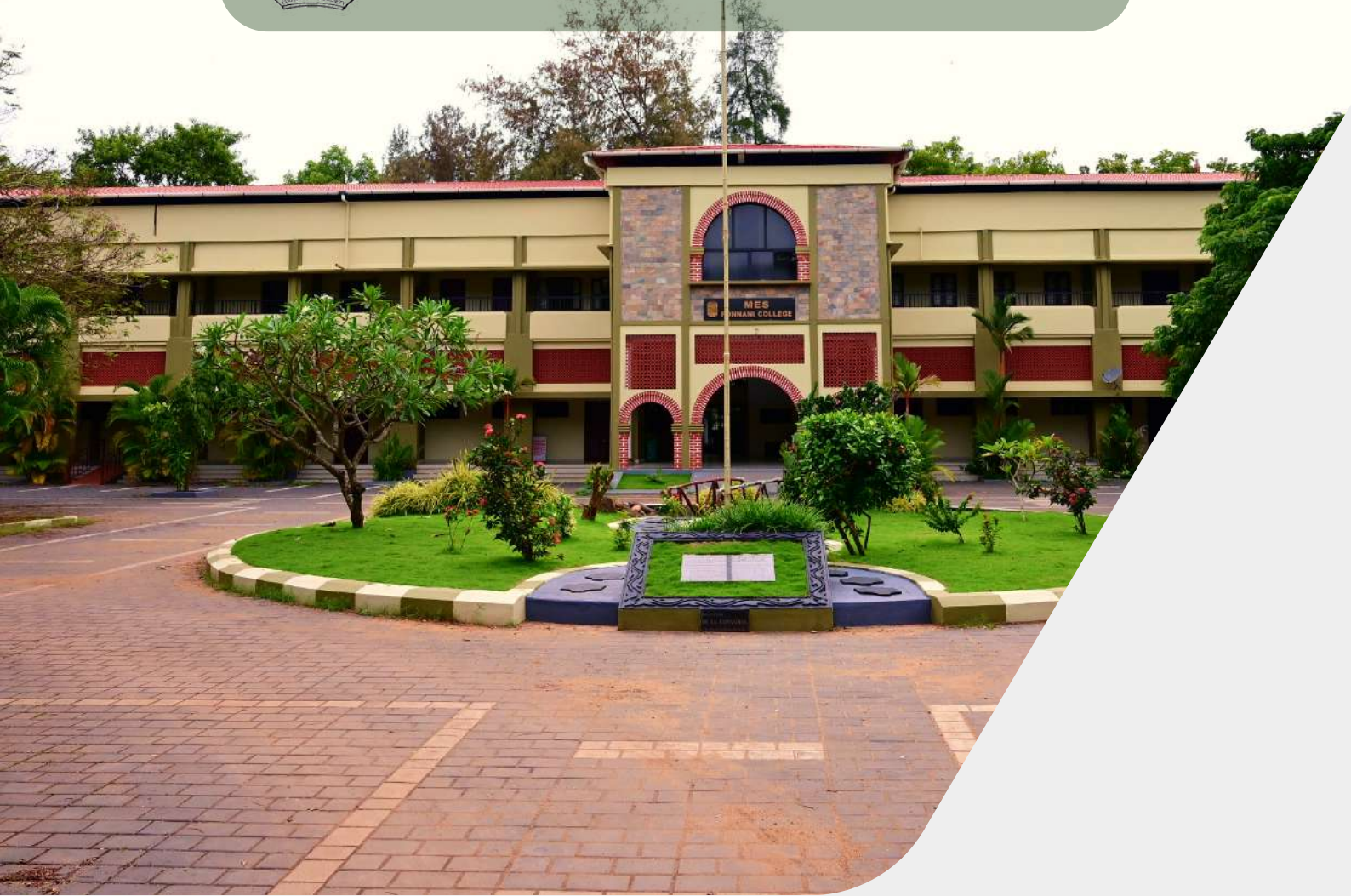

GANDHI CHAIR

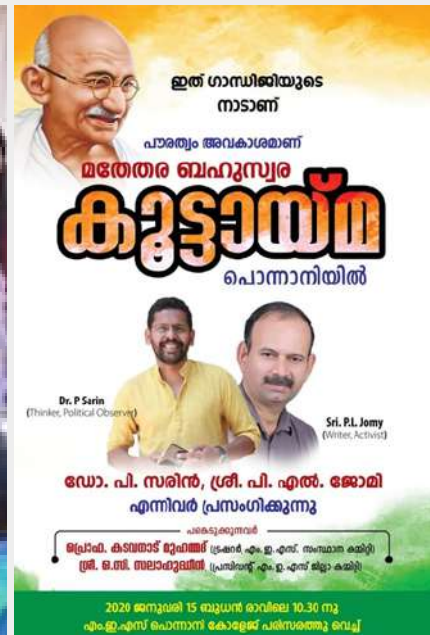

DAKSHAYANI VELAYUDHAN CORNER

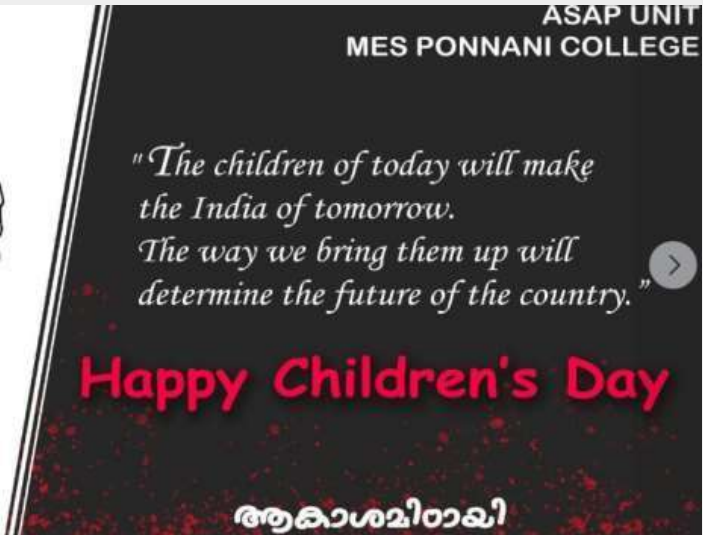
Institution library has got a Dakshayani Velayudhan Corner to inspire the readings on constitution and to inculcate the constitutional values and objectives.

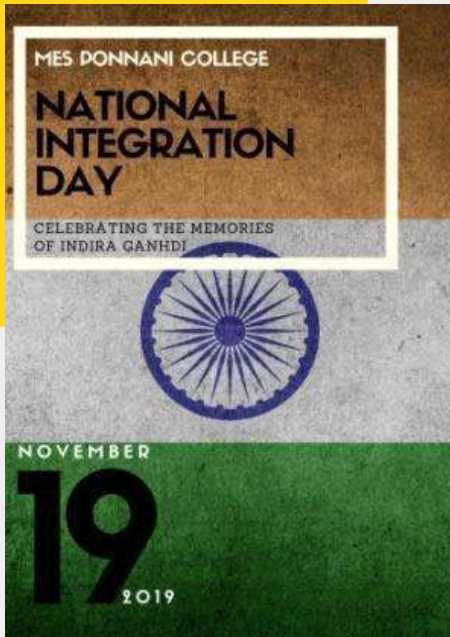


INSTITUTION CELEBRATING CHILDREN'S DAY

NATIONAL INTEGRATION DAY



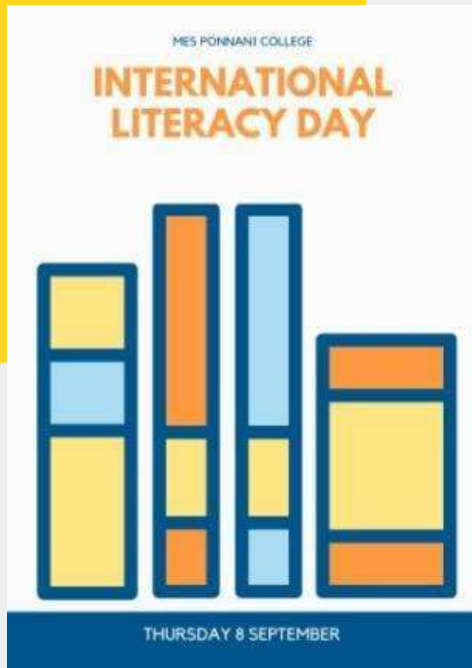

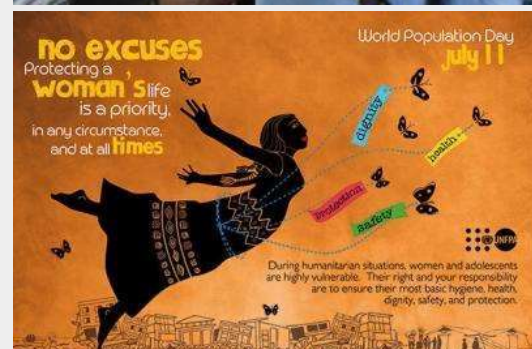
WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR



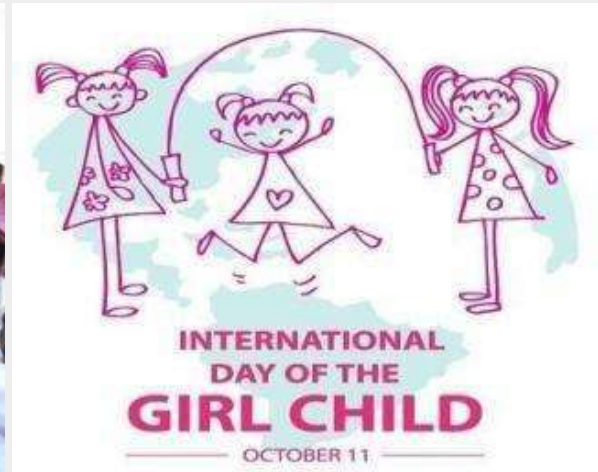

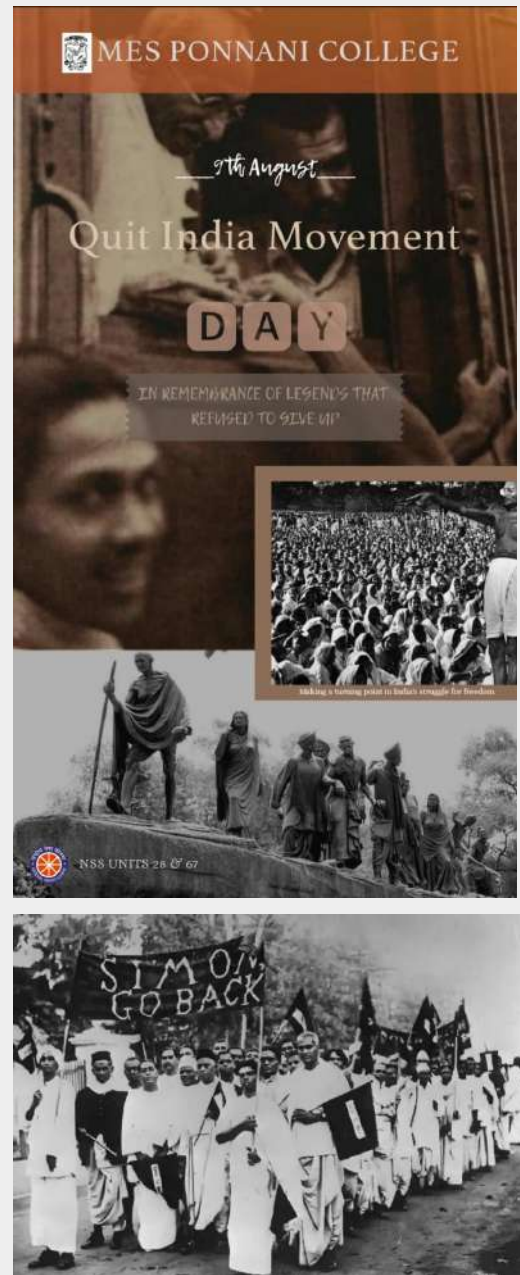

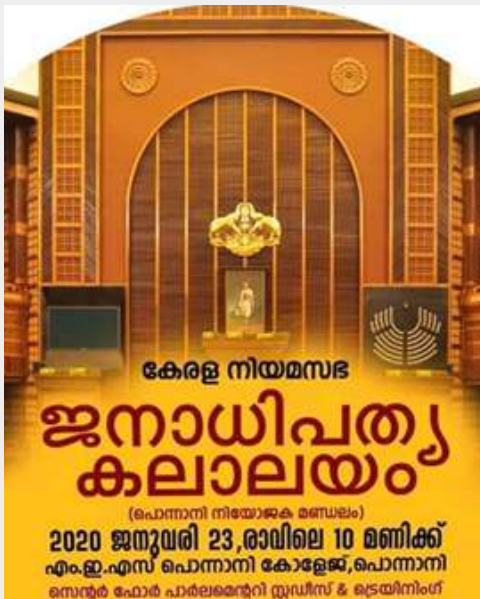
QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT DAY

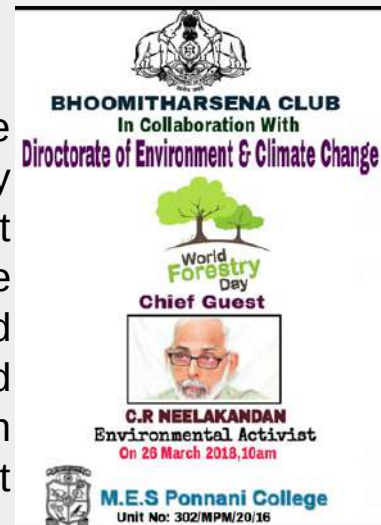

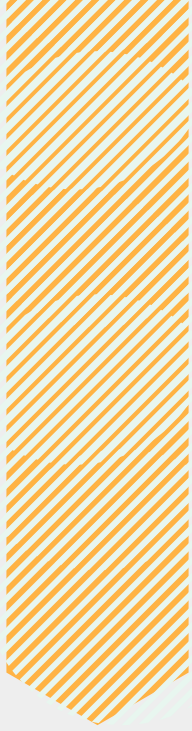


COLLEGE MAGAZINE
