Based on the guidelines of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala, the College Council have recommended five courses from each year undergraduate courses to be offered under SSP. Altogether 150 students have availed the benefits of the programme, comprising 50 students from each year. Ten students were selected to each course as per the guidelines and recommendations of the council. Classes were arranged according to the convenience of both the students and the resource persons. Eight sessions each were conducted for I, II, III and IV Semester UG Programmes. Since the government order regarding the implementation/continuation of the programme was received in November, only after the completion of V Semester, the programme was restricted only for VI Semester courses. The faculty members engaging classes have prepared study materials in the form of detailed notes, prints/copies from essential parts of the text books and important questions and answers booklets. The study materials have been distributed to the students at the beginning sessions of every semester. A total number of 108 books for all the disciplines covered under the scheme for the year 2015-16 were also purchased based on the recommendations of the College Council. The books are made available in respective department libraries for the use of students and faculty members. All the students enrolled under the scheme were also supplied with a stationery kit as per the guidelines. A feedback session with the scholars was also conducted to know about the overall effectiveness of the scheme. A sum of Rs. 186,500/- (Rupees One Lakh eighty six thousand and five hundred only) was received to meet various expenses incurred under the scheme during the academic year 2015-16. As per the sanction order of the Director of Collegiate Education (No. 1648/WWS/2016 dated 03/03/2016) for utilizing the unspent balance to other permissible items, a total of Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty-five thousand only) has been utilized for obtaining books and other study materials, in place of

the initial grants of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only). Out of the total grant received, Rs. 167,000/- (Rupees One Lakh and sixty seven thousand only) have been only utilized for conducting the programme. The unspent balance amount of Rs. 19,500/- (Rupees Nineteen thousand and five hundred has been refunded to the SSP Account (with Challan Computer seq. no. 308, dated 30.03.2016) and the account was closed on 31-3-2016.

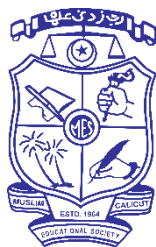
