
WORLD HEALTH DAY



AMBEDKAR JAYANTHI



WORLD HERITAGE DAY





MOTHERS DAY



RED CROSS DAY





VOLUNTEERING ON SOOFI QAWALI PROGRAM







Soofi Qawwali is a form of devotional music that originated in the Indian subcontinent, and is associated with the Sufi tradition of Islam. It is a form of mystical poetry that is sung in a melodious and rhythmic style, with the goal of creating a spiritual connection between the performer and the audience. Ponnani is known for its rich cultural heritage, which includes the tradition of Qawwali music. Qawwali has a long history in Ponnani, dating back to the 16th century, when the town was an important center of Islamic learning and culture. Qawwali performances were held in the local mosques and madrasas, and were an important part of the spiritual and cultural life of the community. The tradition of Qawwali in Ponnani was further strengthened in the 19th century, when the famous Sufi saint and musician, Ustad Hafiz Ahmed Khan Sahib, settled in the town. 
ONAM CELEBRATION


WELCOMING NEWCOMERS


HOSPITAL CLEANING


11/10/2022


ANTI-DRUG QUIZ COMPETITION







MEDICAL CAMP





ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION ON ROAD SAFETY WEEK




