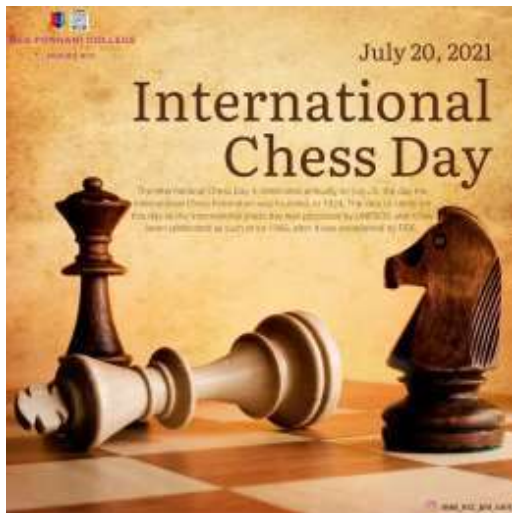
The NCC unit prepared a poster in connection with the international justice day on July 17

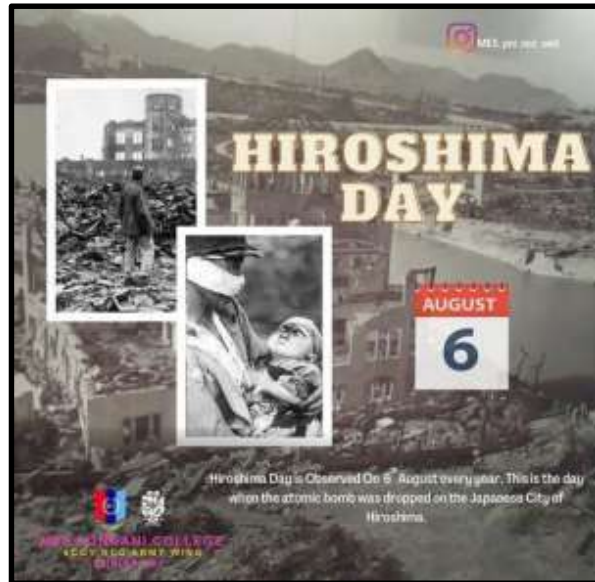

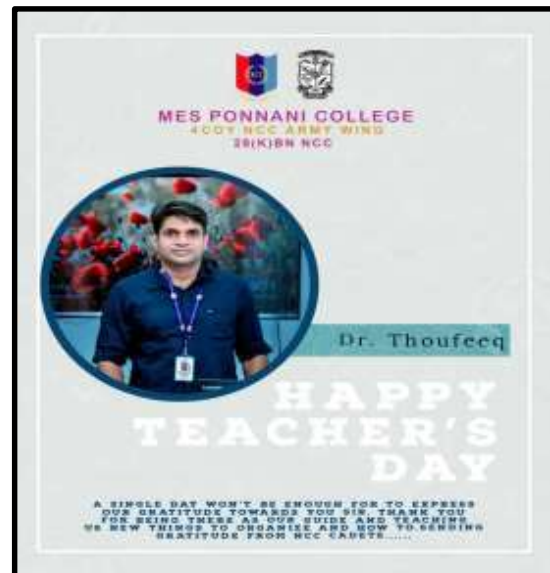

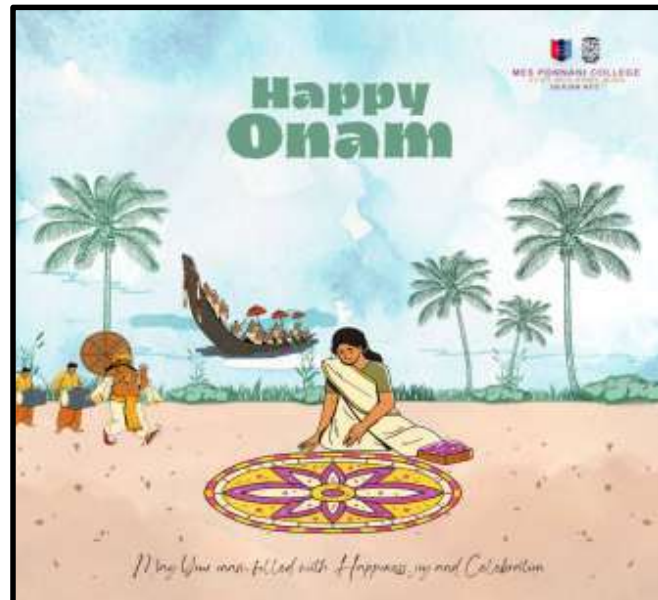
**SEPTEMBER-5

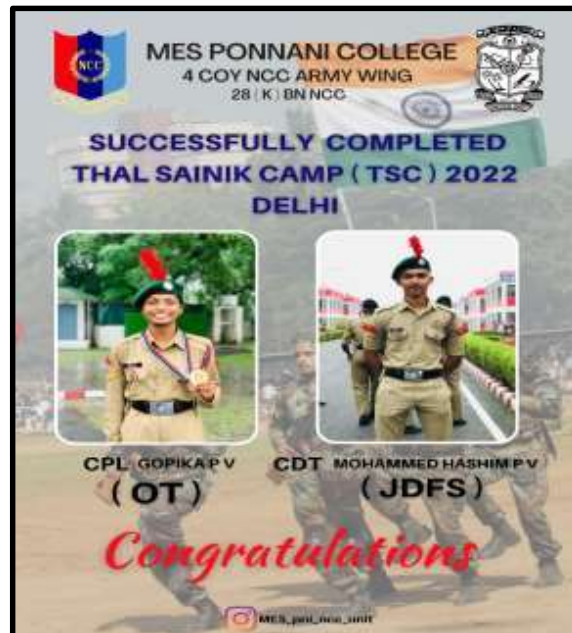

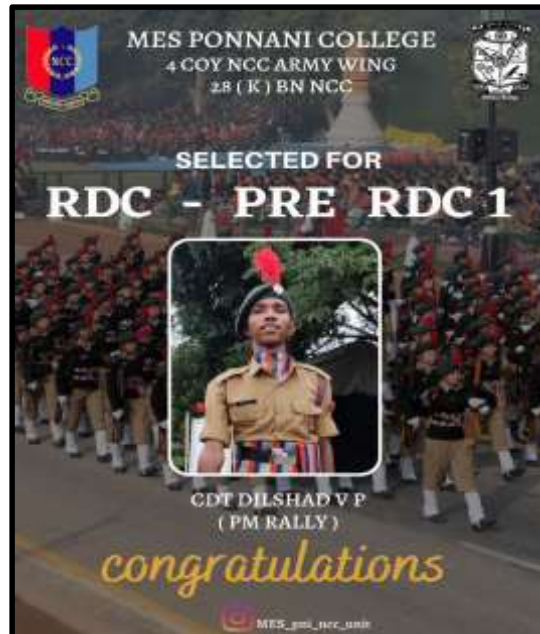
NOVEMBER -1

NOVEMBER -21

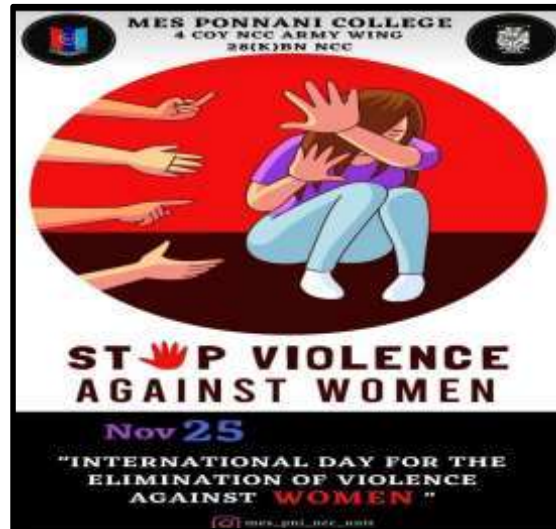
PUNEET SAGAR ABHIYAAN

NCC DAY

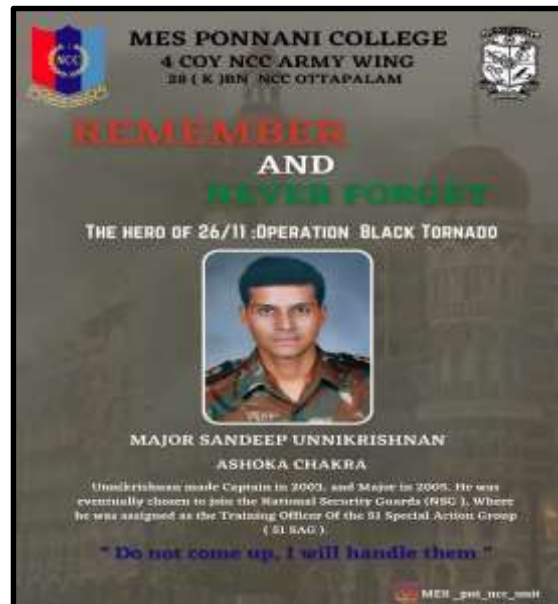

REMEMBERING THE HERO



Major Sandeep Unnikrishnan was an Indian Army Officer, who was assigned as the Training Officer of the 51 Special Action Group (51 SAG) of the National Security Guards on deputation. He was commissioned on 12th June 1999 as a lieutenant in the Bihar Regiment of the Indian Army, later promoted to Captain in 2003 and Major in 2005. He was killed in November 2005 at the Mumbai attacks (**Operation Black Tornado**). He was consequently awarded the **Ashoka Chakra**, India's highest peacetime gallantry award, on 26 January 2009. 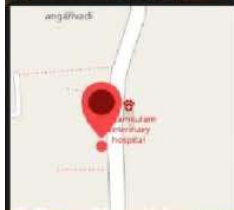
Extreme poverty Eradication scheme: On behalf of the survey to find the extreme poverty in Kerala, a preliminary session was held at Vattamkulam Panchayath on 17 Dec for giving an idea about the scheme. This scheme aimed at identifying those living in extreme poverty and preparation of microplans to help them come out of such a condition.

This survey was on 23 Dec under the presence of 19 Nss volunteers. There were 19 wards in Vattamkulam Panchayath. Volunteers were scattered to each ward accompanied under the guidance of particular Ward member. Details were collected from each house; about the availability of basic needs and were noted in the provided application (Enumeration).

A sum up condition of each households were accurately informed in the panjayath soon after the survey.

The remaining ward (some houses) were completed by the following 2 days.
