
The session concluded with Ms. Anupama Murali, Head of the Department of English at MES Ponnani College, delivering the vote of thanks.




Collaborative Activity Department of English


SCOPE OF THE MOU

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangement for collaboration. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment for such exchange will be worked out between the institutes.

Student Exchange

Dept. of Zoology, HM COLLEGE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, MANJERI and Dept. of Zoology, MES Ponnani College agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study.

- Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- His/her programme/course of the study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "intern" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue letter to that effect.
- To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home institution.
- The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

Other Areas

- To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational programs
- To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- To jointly organize seminar, conferences or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate there in
- Use laboratory facilities in specific cases for limited period. Both partner institutions
 agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be

 responsible for its implementation.

SECTION 3 - IMPLEMENTATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of Dept. of Zoology HM COLLEGE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, MANJERI and Dept. of Zoology, MES PONNANI COLLEGE will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

Both partner institutions agrees that this MoU doesn't mandatorily hold any legal provision or abide any legal rights to partner institutions as part of the conditions mentioned in the purpose and objectives of MoU.

- is known to the Party making the disclosure before its receipt and not subject to any obligation of confidentiality to another party; or
- is or becomes publicly known without any breach of this MoU or any other undertaking to keep it confidential; or
- has been obtained by the Party making the disclosure from a third party in circumstances where the Party making the disclosure has no reason to believe that there has been a breach of an obligation of confidentiality; or
- iv. has been independently developed by the Partner making the disclosure; or
- v. is disclosed pursuant to the requirement of any law or regulation or the order of any Court of competent jurisdiction, and the Party required to make that disclosure has informed the other Party whose information it is, within a reasonable time after being required to make the disclosure, of the requirement to make the disclosure and the information required to be disclosed; or
- vi. is approved for release in writing by an authorized representative of the Party whose information it is.
