

## **NCC ANNUAL REPORT 2014-2015**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

The National Cadet Corpse, after its inception in 1948, has been growing steadily and continuously in the years past and has now reached the status of the largest youth organization in Asia. Variety enriched programmes including camps of different types organized at national, state and unit levels, mould the young blood of the country to develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsman ship and ideals of selfless services and make them useful citizen capable of shouldering responsibilities in various walks of life. NCC has 17 Deputy Directorates. The Deputy Directorate of Kerala and Lakshadweep region has 39 units under five NCC Group Head Quarters. 28 Kerala BN NCC, Ottappalam is the unit to which the subunit of NCC at the college is affiliated.

#### **SUB UNIT OF NCC AT THE COLLEGE**

MES Ponnani College has one company of NCC, Coy-4, with an authorized cadet strength of 74. At present the cadetship is for 3 years.

#### **ENROLMENT**

The activities of NCC at the college commenced with fresh enrolment. The enrolment took place on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. PI staff from NCC HQ Ottappalam came over here and selected students based on their physical and mental abilities and talents in cultural and sports events. Students, both boys and girls, were selected. A total of 36 students (26 boys and 10 girls) were selected and enrolled. Sri Mohammed Maroof Abdul Majeed and Muneer T were given extension to third year service in NCC to equip them to attend NCC 'C' Certificate examination.

#### **TRAINING ACTIVITIES**

The training activities of the report year commenced on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 and concluded on 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2015. The training programmes included parades, WT, Field craft training,

lecturer classes on various NCC subjects, social activities, cultural activities, drill etc. Shameem Rahman V.P. was selected as senior under officer; Mohammed Maroof Abdul Majeed and Jasir C.V. were selected as under officers

## **INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION**

On 15<sup>th</sup> August, cadets assembled in the college campus. Prof. A.M. Rasheed , Principal of the college, hoisted the national flag. He gave Independence Day message. Captain M.N. Mohamed Koya, ANO, gave introductory speech.

## **PARADES**

15 parades were held for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year NCC cadets and 18 parades were held for first year NCC cadets. Most of the parades were held on Saturdays. PI staff from NCC Head Quarters at Ottappalam came over here on parade days to instruct the cadets on all disciplines of NCC. They conducted drill, map reading classes, WT, field craft training and lecture classes. A few classes were taken by me being ANO of the college.

Only a few cadets could attend NCC parades in the report year since the number of camps conducted in the year was very limited. The camp was mainly aimed at developing skills in firing, stripping and outstripping of weapons, field crafts, map reading and drill with arms. 65 cadets from our college attended the mini camp.
