#### INTRODUCTION

#### SUB UNIT OF NCC AT THE COLLEGE

MES Ponnani College has one company of NCC, Coy-4, with an authorized cadet strength of 108. At present the cadetship is for 3 years.

### **ENROLMENT**

The activities of NCC at the college commenced with fresh enrolment. The enrolment took place in August, 2017. Col.
