JUNE 13-Blood Donation Camp



JULY 16 - TREE PLANTATION PAKHWADA



JULY 28 -WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY




AUGUST 6 & 9 - DAYS OF HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI


AUGUST 15 - WEBINAR ON CAREER GUIDANCE

AUGUST 30 - ONAM FESTIVAL


NCC Unit, MES Ponnani College celebrated Kerala festival Onam and prepared a poster wishing happy Onam to everyone in 30th August 2020.


SEPTEMBER 8 - INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY

SEPTEMBER 30 – HONOURING KRISHNAN SAAB




NOVEMBER 1- KERALA PIRAVI CELEBRATIONS

DECEMBER 1-WORLD AIDS DAY






to better recovery and it also emphasizes that inclusive COVID-19 recovery can only be achieved with integrity.





the dedication to the motherland by being effective responders during calamities and through the contributions to wider nation-building. Indian Army enjoys a distinctive pride of place in the national mind space.




JANUARY 26- REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS






JANUARY 28 - MASK & SANITIZER DISTRIBUTION


JANUARY 30 - BLOOD DONATION






FEBRUARY 2021








FEBRUARY 3 - FOOD MATERIAL DELIVERY


FEBRUARY 4 - WORLD CANCER DAY

FEBRUARY 11 - PAADHEYAM PATHAYORAM FOOD DELIVERY




MARCH 2 – DUE BALL SOUTH ZONE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

CDT Gopika won a place in the due ball girls team of the 1st South zone National championship held in Tamil Nadu.




MARCH 8 -INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

MARCH 21 - INTERNATIONAL DAY OF FOREST



APRIL 12 - CALICUT UNIVERSITY INTERZONE


KALARIPPAYATTU CHAMPIONSHIP


APRIL 20 - TOGETHER WE CAN FIGHT CORONAVIRUS


MAY 22 - INTERNATIONAL BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY DAY
