- For PG and Professional Courses: Lump sum grant, monthly stipend, reimbursement of tuition fee, special fee and exam fee subject to income limit.
- Fee is sanctioned once in an Academic year and paid to institution's Account.
- LSG is sanctioned once in a year, stipend and mess Charges are sanctioned are credited to students bank Account.

2. Fee Concession to other students

All other students whose parental annual income does not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- limits are eligible for full fee concession and university examination fee for Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses respectively.

3. Poor Students Aid Fund

A fund is maintained by collecting donations from the staff and the students of the college and public to help the poor and deserving students by giving them scholarship and other kind of help. The beneficiaries are identified and recommended by the respective tutors.
