



They rated the course in five categories which are excellent, very good, good, average and poor. In its graphical representation the horizontal axis represents the percentage response and the vertical axis represents the feedback from the students. Out of a total number of 590 students 12.0% are of the opinion that the relevance of the unit in syllabus related to the course is excellent. 17.6% voted for very good and 39.5% the majority opted good. Less than a









Graph6- As far as the selection of the elective papers in the course is concerned with the students were required to rate the relevance of elective courses to the further





answered the question. In the graphical representation the horizontal line represents the percentage the vertical line represents the feedbacks.
































