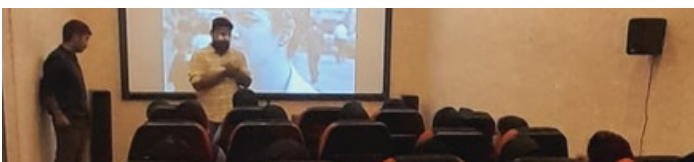
PARIVARTAN: INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR STUDENTS

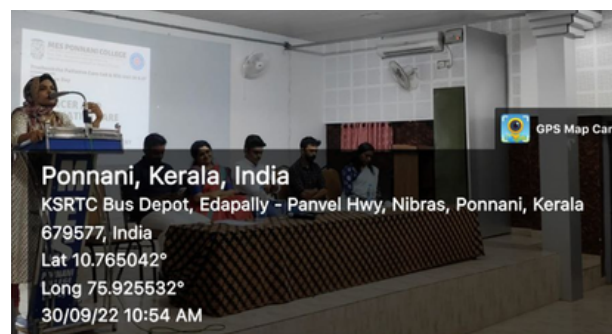
INTERNATIONAL DAY OF DEMOCRACY

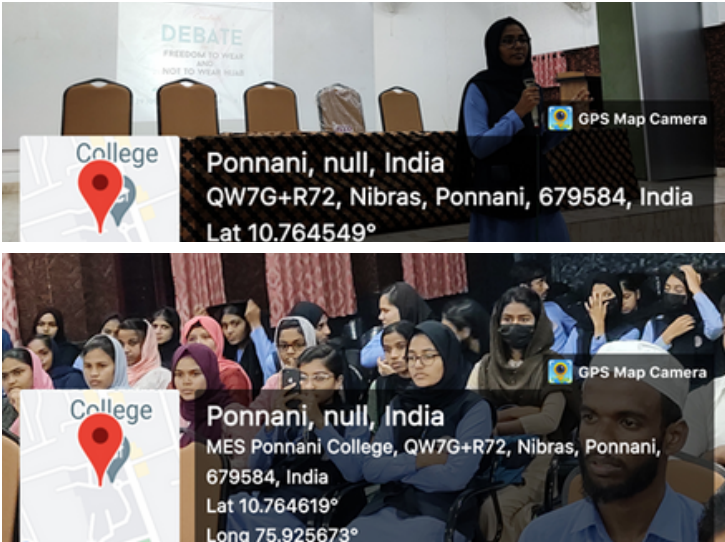
GIRLS WITH GOALS: EXTENSION PROGRAMME

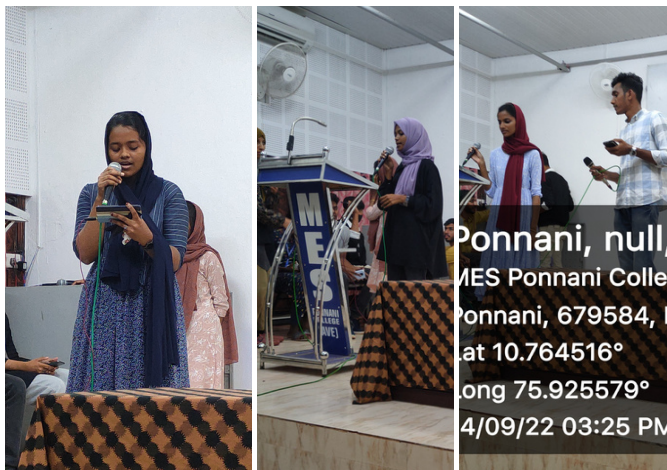
DEBATE

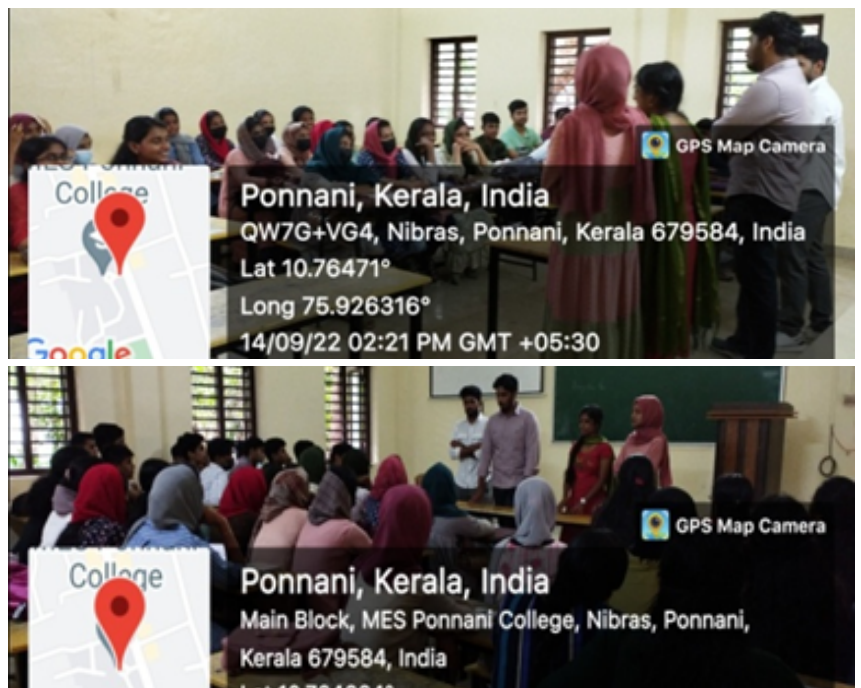


NATIONAL HINDI DAY

Students explored various biodiversity hotspots in Kerala such as Mangalavanam Bird Sanctuary in Kochi, Vagamon Meadows, Thekkady Periyar Tiger Reserve, Elephant Camp at Thekkady. They also visited the Chinnar Wildlife Sanctuary, Thoovanam Waterfalls, Sacred Heart College Natural History Museum at Shenbaganur, Central Sheep and Wool Research Institute at Kodaikanal which is a premier institute of Indian Council of Agricultural Research primarily engaged in research, training and extension activities on sheep and rabbits, and Eravikulam National Park, a renowned ecological, faunal, geomorphological and zoological hotspot. Trekking through the Chinnar Wildlife Sanctuary offered the students an amusing experience. The students experienced different types of forests, spotted diverse animals and plant species, and explored the natural beauty of Munnar and natural sandalwood forest in Marayur. The tour was successful in achieving its goals.





LAB VISIT

As a part of curriculum, fifth semester B. Sc. Zoology students visited the museums and Microbiology lab of the Department of Aquaculture & Fishery Microbiology of the college. Dr. Rajool Shanis. C. FIELD VISIT

As a part of curriculum, the Department of Botany conducted four days study cum collection tour to Wayanad, Coorg and Chikmagalur from 27th to 30th September 2022. Twenty two students from the fifth semester B Sc Botany programme were participated. The field visit was intended to give an exposure for the students to explore diverse plant groups, their different ecological sites and to visit research institution and places of biological importance. Students collected many Pteridophytes and various angiosperms from the Wayanad Ghat region. They visited the M. S. Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), which is a leading institute engaged in research on Conservation Biology, Biotechnology, Plant Taxonomy, Microbiology, Phytopharmacology, Ethno medicine and Ethopharmacology. Mr. Jithin N. M, the Garden Manager, explained the taxonomic features of many plants present in and around MSSRF garden. Students also visited the glass house, fern house, orchid house etc. in the Regional Agricultural Research Station, Ambalavayal, and experienced many ornamental and economically important species of plants in the nursery. During the drive to Coorg they experienced various plants in different altitude, coffee and tea plantations, variety of vegetations etc. Another attraction of the field study was the trekking expedition inside Kuruvadweep and Kemmangundi to Mullayanagiri Peak which is renowned for its ecological, faunal, geomorphological and botanical significance. They also experienced different types of forests and plant species, and got an opportunity to relish the beauty of the flowered Strobilanthes kunthiana (Neelakurinji) at Kemmangundi and Mullayanagiri hill. Dr. Jyothi P. V, Dr. Musfir Mehaboob and Dr. Soumya, faculty members of Botany accompanied the students. This trip provided a lot of enjoyment and immemorable moments to students and was successful in achieving its goals.

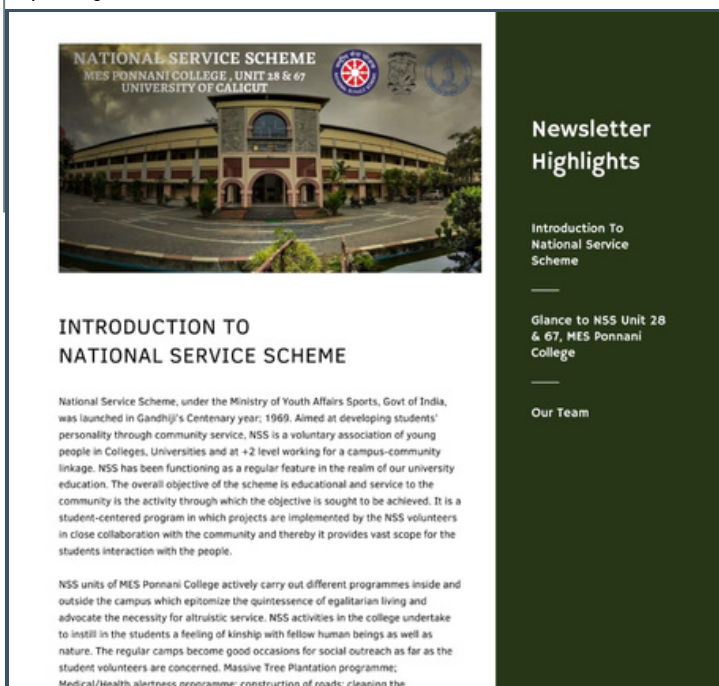


NSS DAY SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT

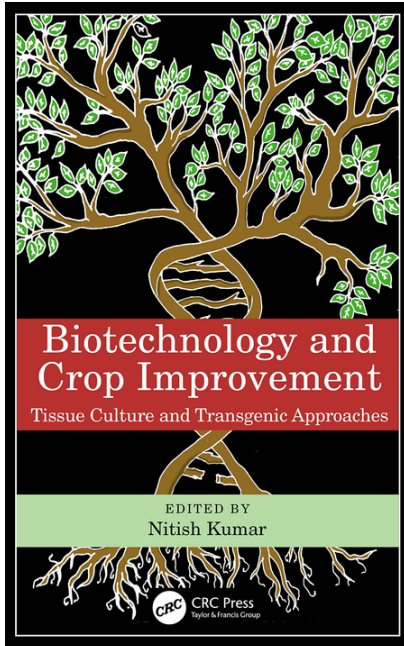
CLASS ON ELECTION LITERACY

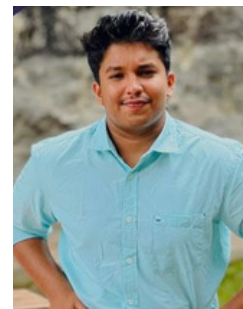

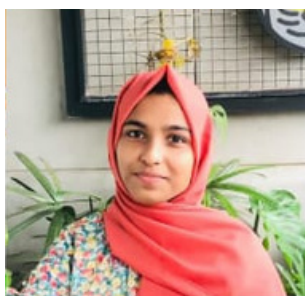

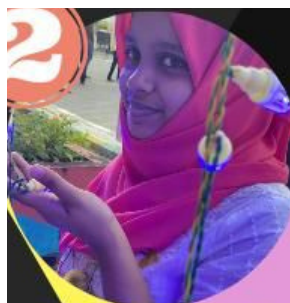
